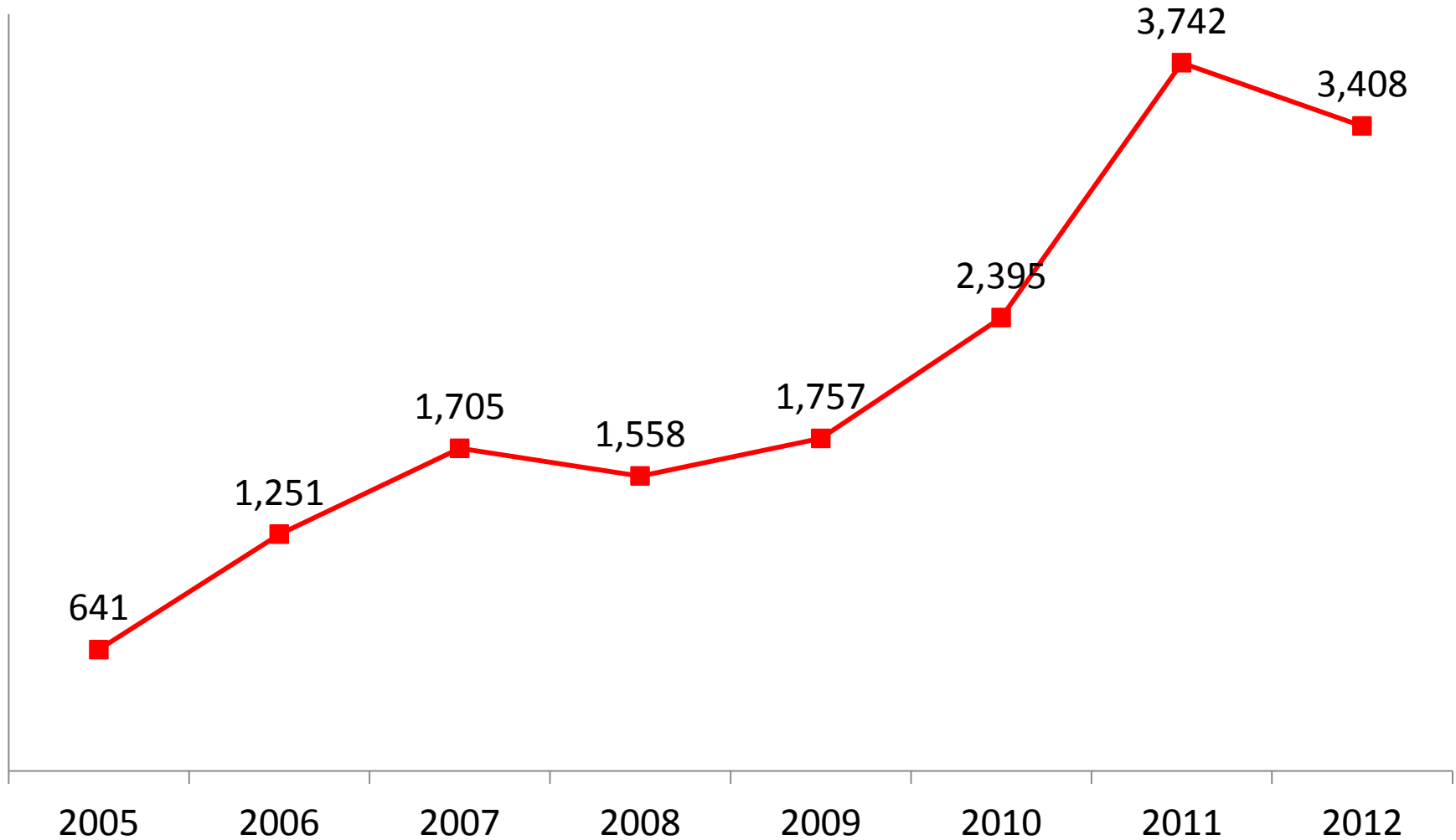
Key Points about the Straw Poll

- Ballots collected online via secure web portal requiring randomly generated one-time-use-only PIN numbers to complete the survey.
- Ballots collected from Thursday morning at 9 a.m. through Saturday afternoon at 1 p.m.
- Only registrants could vote.
- 50 States plus DC represented in the balloting.

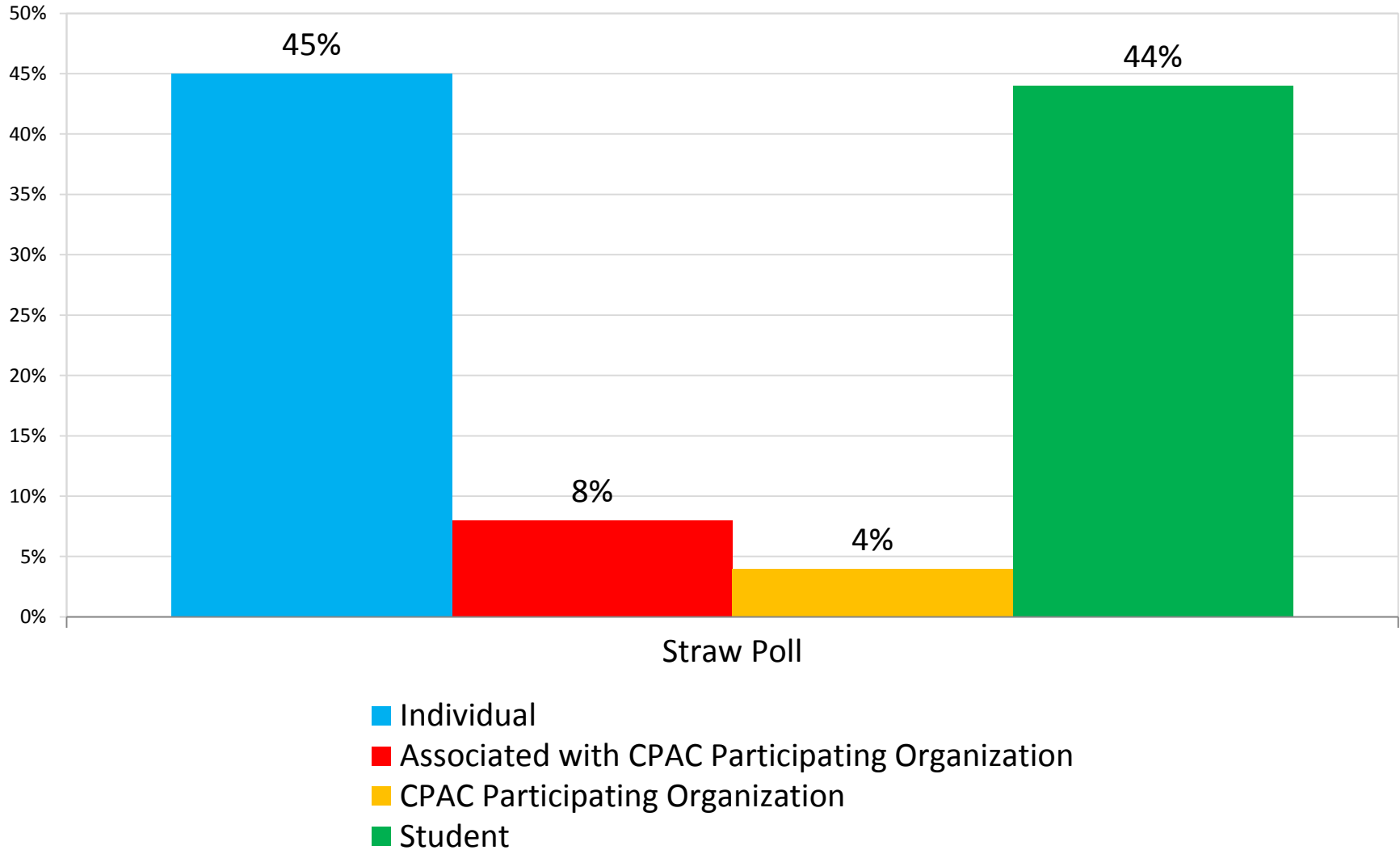
Key Points about the National Survey

- Fabrizio, McLaughlin & Associates conducted a nationwide survey of 600 likely self-identified conservative voters via telephone.
- Interviews were stratified into proportionate geographic units based on previous voter turnout.
- Survey conducted February 7-8, 2012.
- Margin of error at the 95% confidence interval for 600 likely self-identified conservative voters is $\pm 4.00\%$.

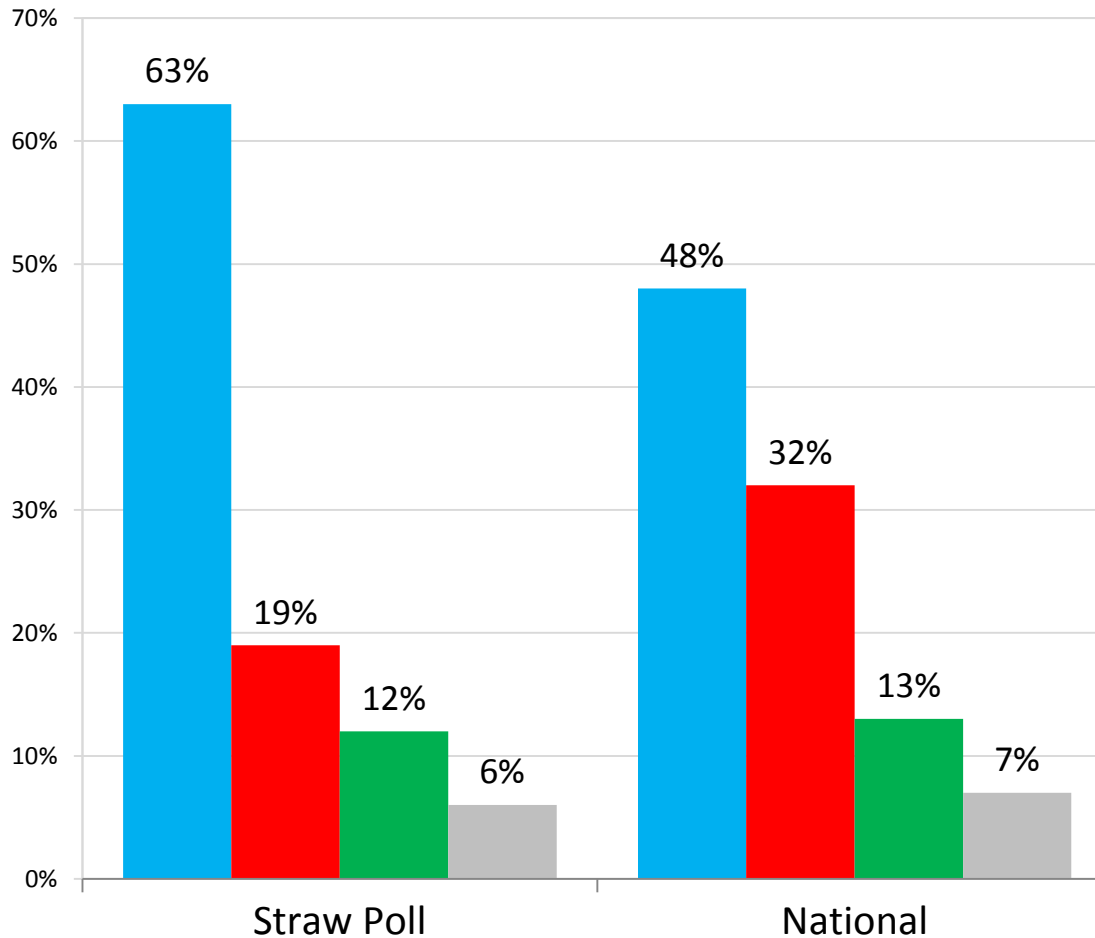
Historical Straw Poll Votes Cast



Type of Registrant



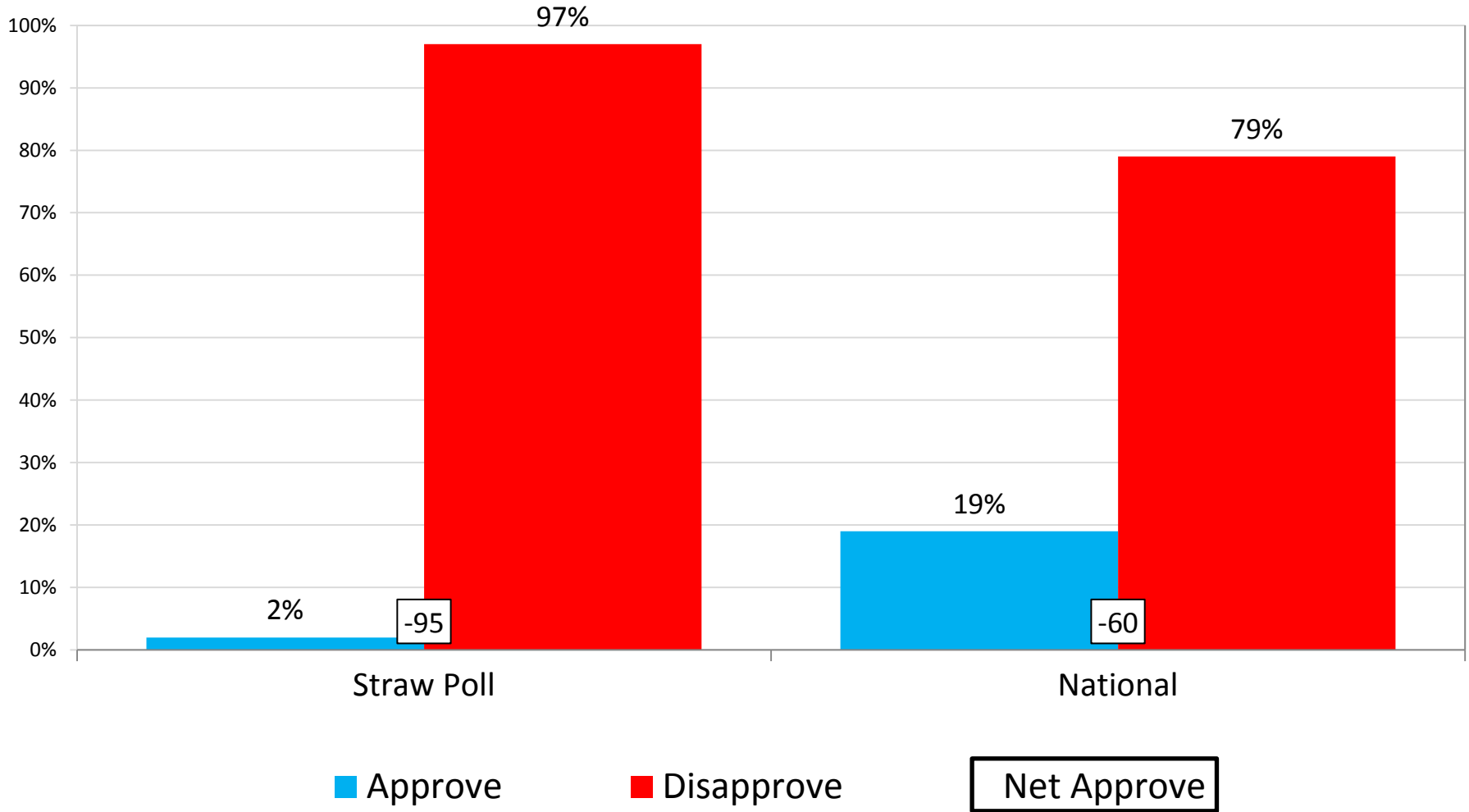
Personal Core Beliefs

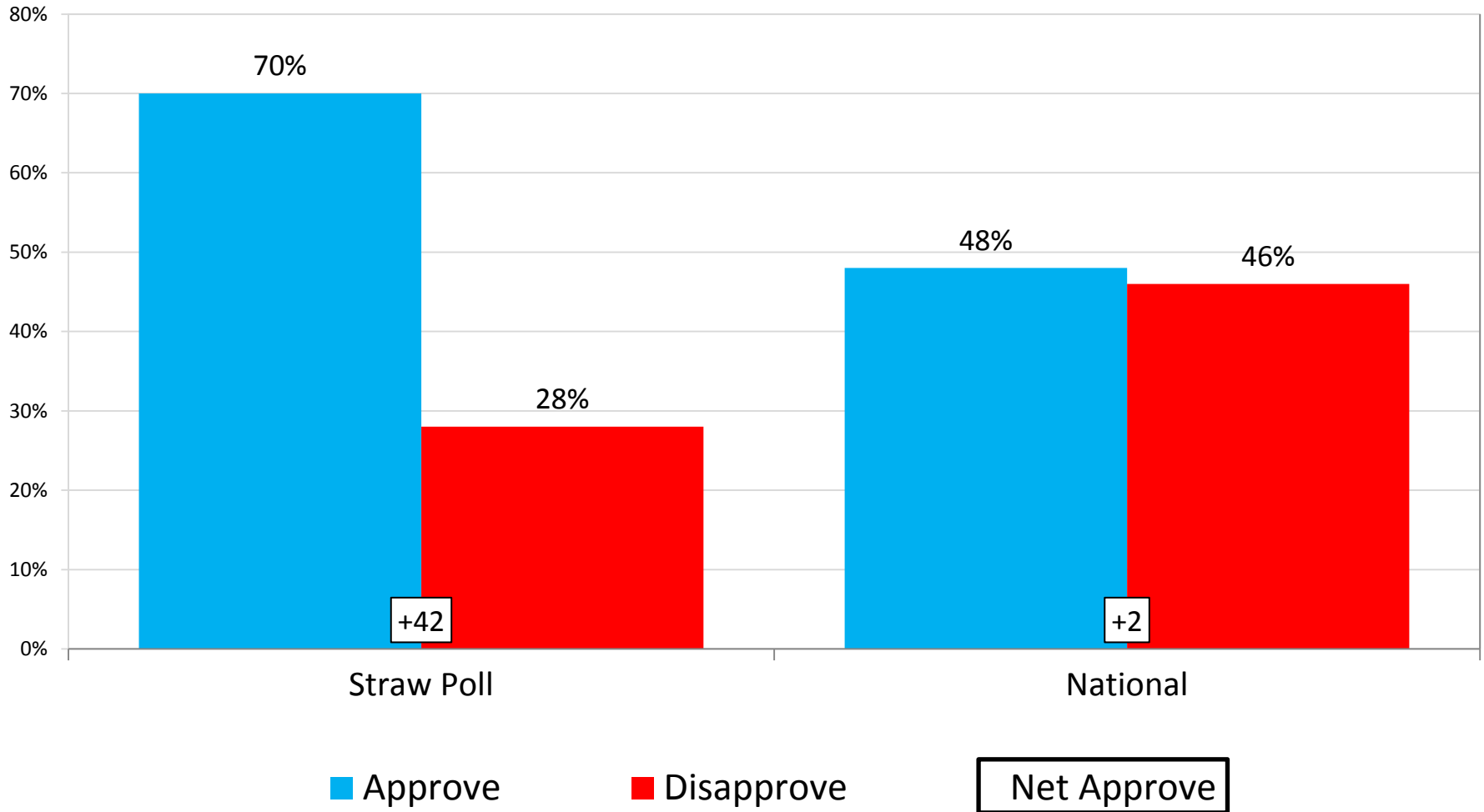
Q. Which ONE of the following comes closest to your core beliefs?

Barack Obama Job Approval



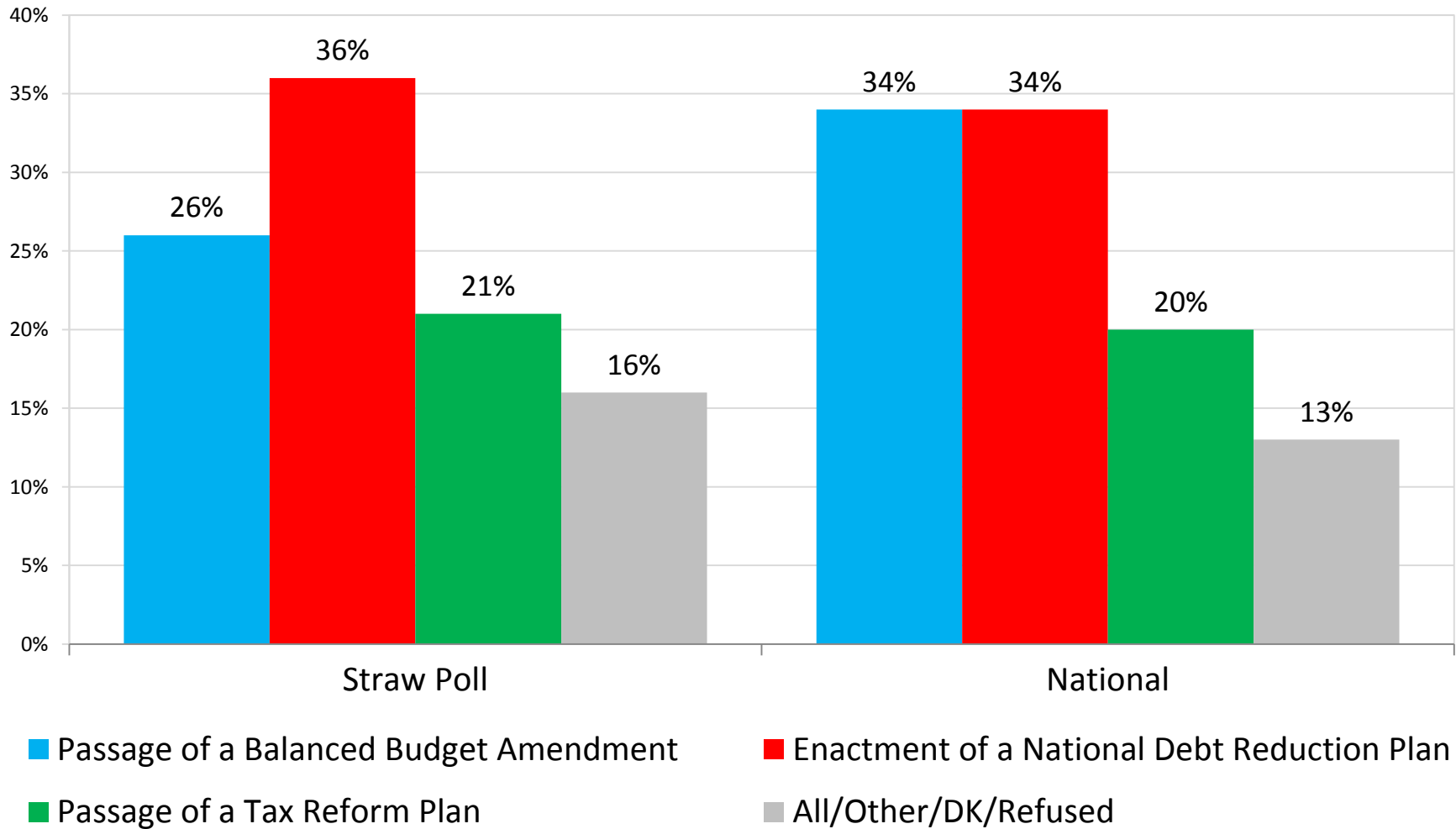
Q. Generally speaking, do you approve or disapprove of the job Barack Obama is doing as President?

GOP in Congress Job Approval



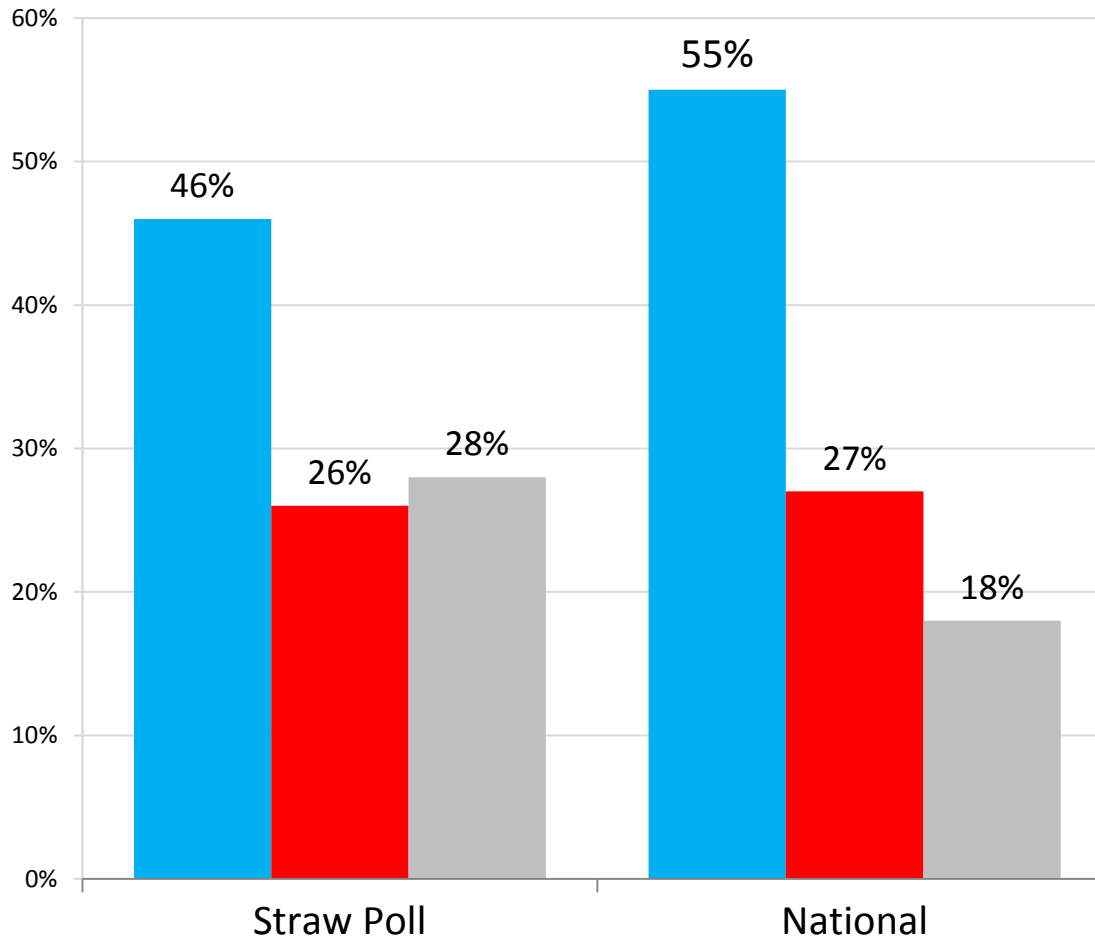
Q. Generally speaking, do you approve or disapprove of the job the Republicans in Congress are doing?

Preferred Tax Reform Plan



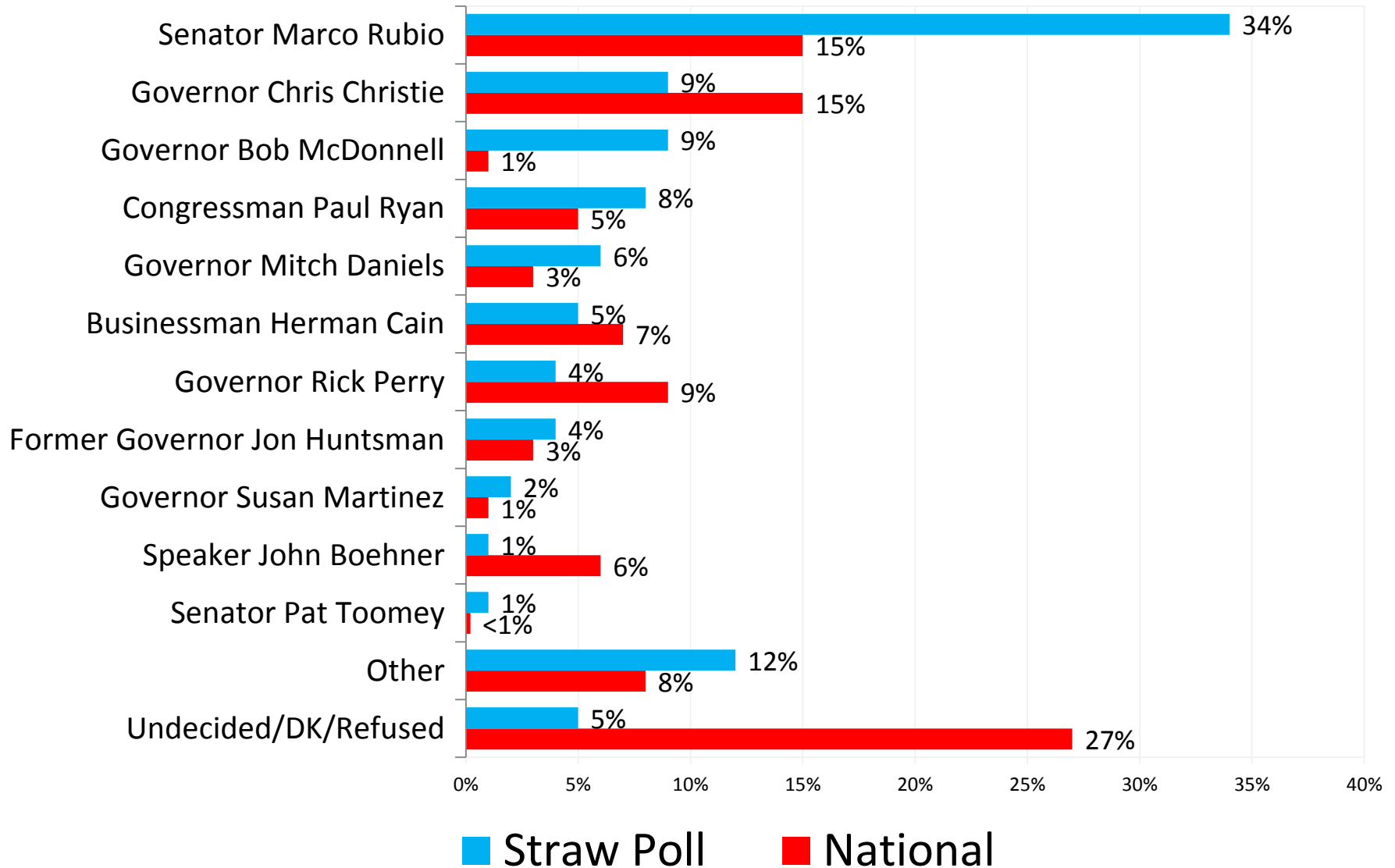

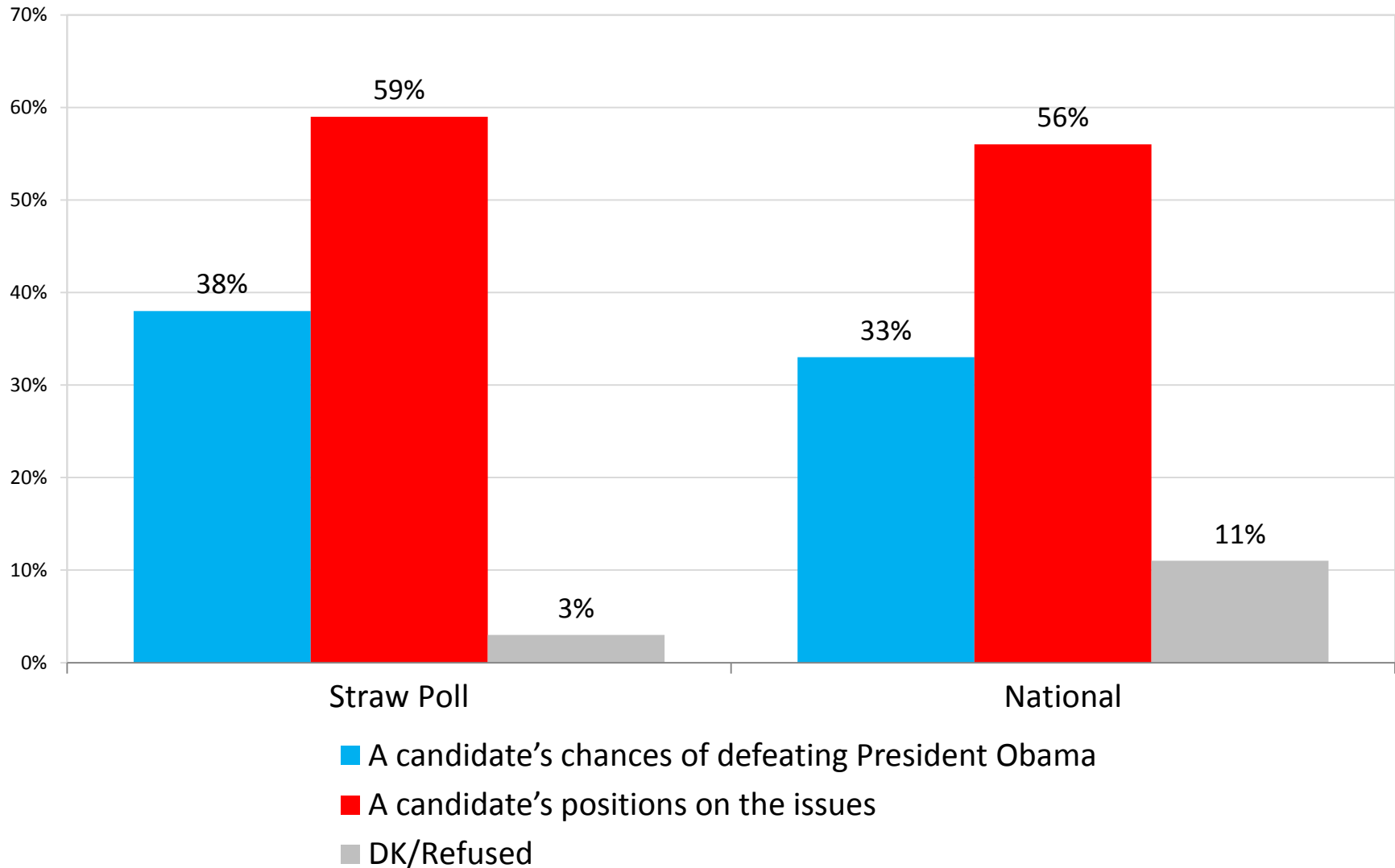
Q. Which of the following tax reform plans would you favor MOST?

GOP Vice-Presidential Choice



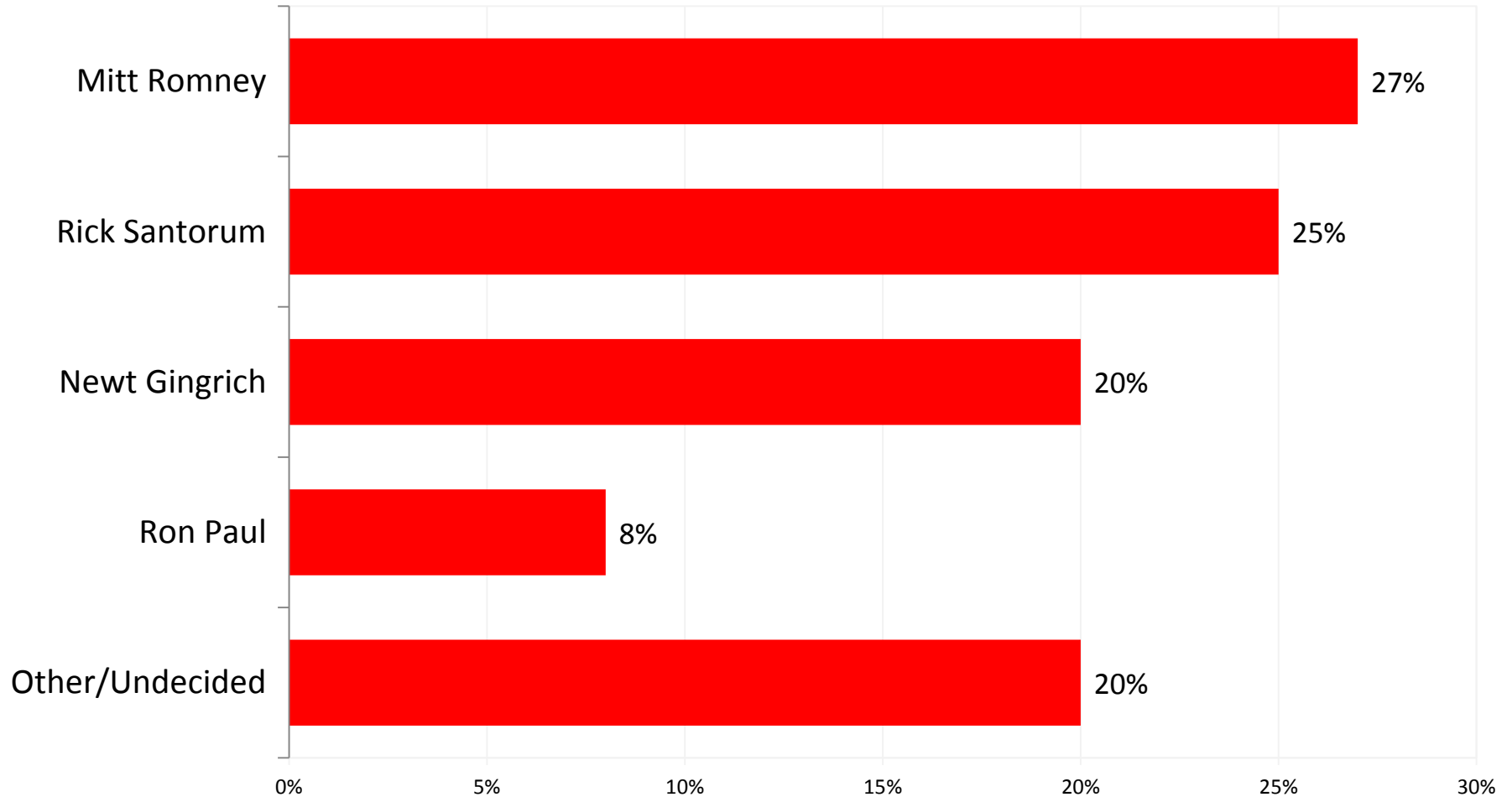

Q. Which of the following is MOST important to you in choosing who you favor for as the Republican Presidential Nominee?

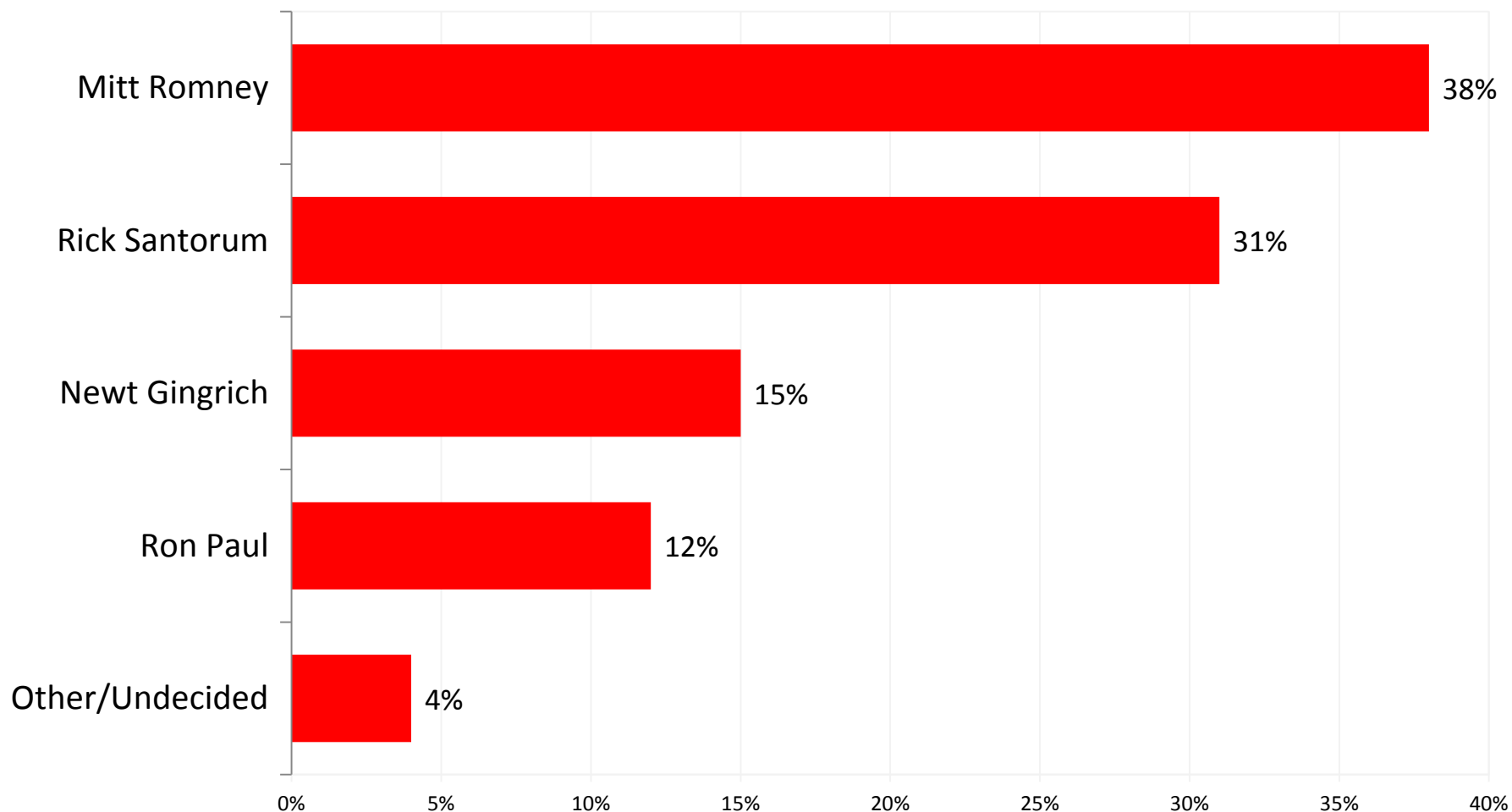

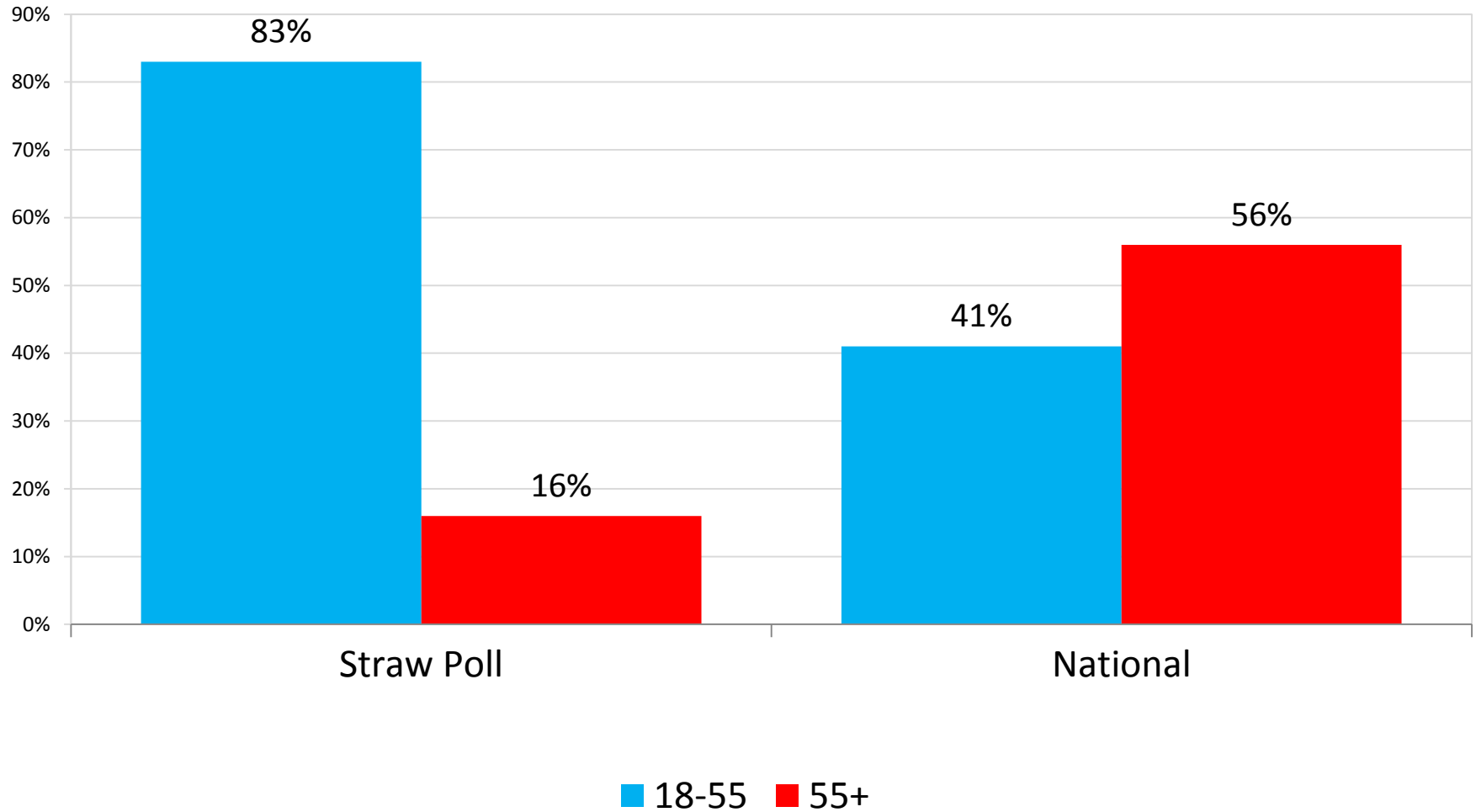
